SAFE WALKING TIPS FOR PEDESTRIANS

A public affairs specialist from AAA offers these safe walking tips for pedestrians.

- Pedestrians have the right of way to cross in crosswalks, marked and unmarked, but should always be aware of their surroundings and look both ways before crossing the street.
- Always cross in the crosswalk or at corners when there is no crosswalk. Don't walk between parked cars; motorists may not see you entering the roadway.
- Remain distraction free and be in tune to the traffic scene when entering and while in the roadway.
- If crossing in other locations, always yield the right-of-way to vehicles. Failure to obey the law carries a fine.
- A few reminders for pedestrians:
 - Walk facing traffic.
 - Wear reflective clothing and be visible to motorists.
 - Stay alert and walk sober.
 - Obey traffic signals such as WALK/DON'T WALK signs.
 - Don't wear headphones or talk on a cell phone while crossing.

Don't assume vehicles will stop. Make eye contact with drivers, don't just look at the vehicle.

My Dear Hamilton by
Stephanie Dray and Laura Kamoie

This book was chock full of history and was a real page turner. It made me want to see the Broadway show, *Hamilton*! To paraphrase Amazon's review:

Coming of age in revolutionary New York, Elizabeth Schuyler champions the fight for independence. When she meets Alexander Hamilton, she's captivated by his charisma and brilliance. But the union they create - their marriage and the new nation - is far from perfect. From glittering inaugural balls to bloody street riots, the Hamiltons are at the center of it all - including the political treachery of America's first sex scandal.

When a duel destroys Eliza's hard-won peace, the grieving widow fights to preserve Alexander's legacy. But long-buried secrets threaten everything Eliza believes about her marriage and her own legacy. Questioning her tireless devotion to the man and country that have broken her heart, she's left with one last battle - to understand the flawed man she married and the imperfect union he could never have created without her.
