New Rules Every Parent Needs
to Know in New Providence, NJ

New eBike ordinances effective December 1, 2025 in New Providence



You've taken the first step. Now keep your rider safe and in compliance with these four simple rules.

No Earbuds/Phones



Operators must hear and focus. No riding with AirPods or phones.

No Sidewalk Riding



eBikes are not allowed on sidewalks, only streets and bike paths if allowed.

Must Be Registered




eBikes must be registered with New Providence and the registration decal visible.

Road Rules Apply



General bike safety rules apply like wearing helmets, riding with traffic, etc.
